Orthopaedic Residency and Manual Therapy Fellowship

Dear Colleague,

You may begin working on your SportsMedicine of Atlanta (SMA) Residency/Fellowship application documents at any time in order to apply to programs that start every 6 months. Please print this page and use it as a check-sheet for your application. Be sure that you indicate on your application which track you wish to apply for. Your application may be for both Residency and Fellowship tracks as dual candidacy can be considered for appropriate applicants. SportsMedicine of Atlanta requires the following documents for a complete application:

(all items are to be submitted through regular mail)

- a personal statement
- a current Curriculum Vitae

- letter of recommendation from your Chief of Service/Department Chairman during residency (Residency Program Director)
- letters of recommendation from *two* (2) additional physical therapists who are qualified to evaluate your ability and qualifications for this fellowship
- transcripts from *all* exams attempted since matriculation in physical therapy school (MTC, COMT, OCS, SCS, CSCS, etc.)
- Physical Therapy School Transcript
- a color photo
- a completed SMA job application (download application from www.SportsMedicineofAtlanta.com website)
- a completed Colloquial Introspective Professional Orientation Project (available from www.SportsMedicineofAtlanta.com website)

Applicants selected to interview will be contacted by email. Interviews will be held at on campus and may also be arranged for APTA CSM, Annual Conference, AAOMPT or PPS conferences.
